COMPETITION RULES

- Open to club members and non-members
- Entry fee: \$35 club members and \$40 non-members (juniors \$20, under 16 years)
- Competition species are Snapper, Kahawai & Trevally
- One fish per species, per angler may be weighed
- Lines in 5:30AM, lines out 4:00PM Saturday 7th October
- All anglers must fish within TPSFC Club boundaries, using rod & reel only
- Braided line is permitted in this tournament, no line weight restrictions apply
- MPI rules re: minimum size limits apply
- Catch sheets to be completed (Club members only)
- Weigh in from 4:30PM 5:30PM Saturday 7th October
- Any disputes must be addressed to the organisers during weigh in period
- Cancellation will be on channel 61 at 5:00AM. If the competition is postponed, it may be rescheduled for another weekend. If cancelled altogether all entry fees will be refunded.

The Tairua Pauanui Sports Fishing Club advises all anglers to be aware of the local Environment Waikato regulations:

All boats should be in a seaworthy condition, have two forms of communication, carry up to date flares. Life jackets must be worn at all times on boats 6m and under. Boats 6m and over must wear life jackets crossing the Tairua Bar. Please make sure you check the weather conditions, bar and tide conditions.
