



## DAIWA LANDBASED TOURNAMENT 2024 RULES

26th, 27th & 28th April

### COMPETITION RULES

- Fishing area is the Coromandel peninsula north of Thames and Whangamata.
- Registration is available online or on Thursday 25th from 1pm, Briefing will start at 6pm.
- Start fishing from 6:00am Friday 26th April.
- All fish must be weighed by 1:00PM Sunday 28th April.
- Weigh in times: Friday 26th 4:00-5:00PM. Saturday 27th April - 4:00PM-5:00PM. Sunday 28th April - 12:00PM-1:00PM.
- Landbased tournament - no boats, contikis, kayaks or flotation devices of any type are permitted.
- Completion of a Landbased Tournament entry form deems acceptance of the rules.
- Any disputes will be handled by the Tournament Committee and any complaint must be signed by the team leader and handed to the weighmaster by 1:00 PM Sunday 23rd April. Any decision will be final and no further discussion will be entered into.
- Catch sheets for qualifying fish MUST be filled in before weighing. It is the angler's responsibility, not the weigh masters.
- Anglers may weigh two fish of each species during the competition. *MPI rules and minimum size limits apply*

### SPEEDFISHING:

- Speed Fishing will take place on Sunday 28th April and will consist of a 60 minute "fish off" commencing at 1:300PM with lines out by 2:30PM. From the club to the bar beacon heaviest fish (excluding rays/sharks) wins.
- Speedfish weigh in 2:30PM-3:00PM.
