Visitor's Berth

First in, first serve but multiple smaller boats can fit as the berth is 17m.

Weighing Fish

To weigh a fish any day of the week, please contact Cie on 021 448 168 to arrange a weigh master. We have scales for in shore species and a full size gantry for game fish.



Fish Grid

Every year we have a new fish grid which divides our fishing area into 33 squares, each with a different sponsor. When you're out fishing or recording a catch with a weigh master, make sure you report which sponsor's grid it was caught in.

TRANSPORT & PRIZE DRAWS

HOUSE RULES



Members

Members must have a fully paid subscription for the current membership year, They should carry their membership card as identification whenever they are in the Club.



Guests

As a member of the Tairua Pauanui Sports Fishing Club, you are able to bring guests into the Clubrooms. The usual rule of thumb is one guest per TPSFC member. This is especially enforced over summer when the Club is operating at peak capacity.

You must ensure your guests sign in at the bar using the visitor's book. Your guest must be accompanied by you the entire time they are in the Clubrooms. You cannot sign in a guest and then leave the Club.

Once a guest has been signed in on two separate occasions, they must then become a member themselves to visit again.



Visitors

Visitors who are members of another NZ Sports Fishing Council affiliated club must sign the visitor's book, identifying the home club where they are a member and produce their home club membership card as proof of ID.



Club Hours

The Club is open from 3:30PM daily - 365 days a year. Bar Licence hours apply. The Bar Manager or Duty Manager has the right to close the bar earlier than these times should they see fit to do so.



Dress Standards

A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times. No swimwear. No bare feet. Footwear must be clean. Please leave dirty work boots downstairs.



Behaviour

A respectable standard of behaviour and conduct is expected of all members, guests and visitors attending the club. Any violence, foul language, harassment, abuse or bad behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in the member, guest or visitor being asked to leave the Club. Repeated bad behaviour may result in the member, guest or visitor being suspended from the Club. Members will take a responsible approach to the consumption of alcohol.



Clearing Tables

Please remember we are a Club and not a restaurant - we do not employ wait staff. Members are expected to return all used glassware to the bar and plates to the kitchen trolley prior to leaving the club.





Membership Renewal

A reminder that our membership season runs 1 July to 30 June the following year. All members must renew their membership on 1 July regardless of how far through the season you signed up. We cannot offer discounted memberships for a portion of the season due to the fixed affiliation fees we pay to NZSFC for each member.
